



## **DEVELOPMENT SITE FOR SALE**

Offering:

The site is a 241 acre premier mixed-use development site located in Fredericksburg, Spotsylvania County, Virginia, the 13th fastest growing county in the nation.



Site:

Approximately 241 acres in size, comprised of two phases.

Location:

The site is prominently located between I-95, US Route 1, US Route 17 and the Spotsylvania Parkway, **directly adjacent to Cosner's Corner Retail Center**, which comprises 1,500,000 square feet of big box retail space featuring; Super Target, Kohl's, Marshall's, Best Buy, PetSmart, Ross, Staples.

In addition to Cosner's Corner, the site is also **adjacent to the Spotsylvania Regional Medical Center Complex**, a 126-bed general acute care hospital which is currently under construction and is slated to be completed by 2010.

## Development

**Potential:** 

## Phase I – 38 Acres

The magnet site is likely to be developed in multiple phases (see conceptual mater plan). Phase I would include approximately 38 acres adjacent to Cosner's Corner Retail Center, which stands independent from the bulk of the site and can be developed immediately under existing By-Right zoning ("I-1"), which allows up to a 1.0 FAR.

## Phase II – 203 Acres

The bulk of the site is likely to be developed with high density, mixed-use uses in multiple phases under new Urban Development Area zoning ("UDA"). This site is currently being recommended as one of the five UDA's which Spotsylvania County will be obliged to adopt in their Comprehensive Plan by 2011.

Under a UDA classification, development density is expected to be at a minimum of 0.4 FAR (3.5 million square feet for Phase II), designed to foster places for people to "live, work, and play" most likely in under a town center style concept. The County Planning Officials are very receptive to the Sponsor's proposed development concept, and have indicated that the Sponsor can begin the process for mixed-use development utilizing the existing Planned Development Commercial (PDC) zoning ordinance in anticipation of the UDA.
